Language Access and Auxiliary Aids Plan

It is the policy of the Office of the State Attorney that Victim Services staff shall take reasonable steps to provide limited English proficient (LEP) person with meaningful access to all services offered by Victim Services in the Office of the State Attorney. An individual with disabilities (hard of hearing, deaf or LEP) who needs to accommodation in order to participate in a scheduled SAO proceeding, is entitled, at no cost, for certain auxiliary plan assistance. Citizens with disabilities, deaf, hard of hearing, or LEP, who request services or accommodations, must meet SAO criteria in order to obtain services or accommodations from the SAO: the person is a primary victim, secondary victim, or witness in a pending criminal case within the jurisdiction of the 5th Judicial Circuit.
